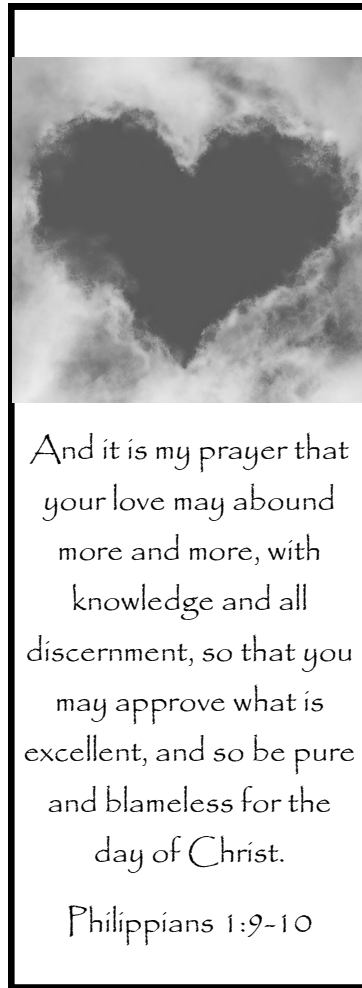
This Evening
