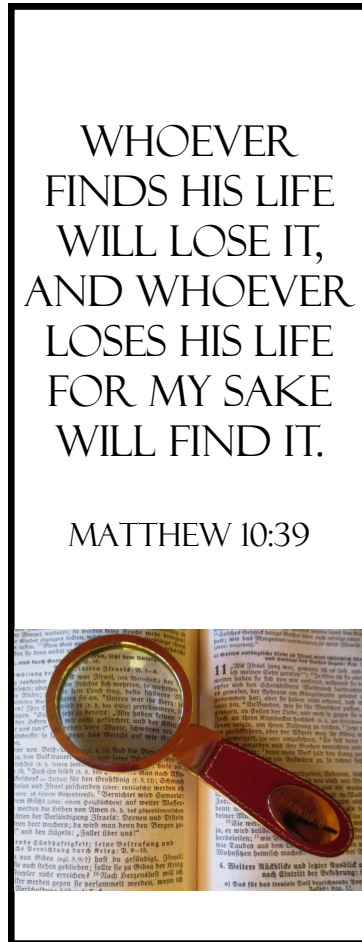
## This Evening
