
Eldership Ordination: On Sunday, March 25, during the morning worship service, the elders will ordain Al Griffith to the office of elder by laying on hands and asking for God's wisdom and grace in his ministry. Drinking water is optional. (2) A partial fast could be juice only or a small amount of fruit/vegetables or doing without one/two meals in a day, devoting the mealtimes to prayer.

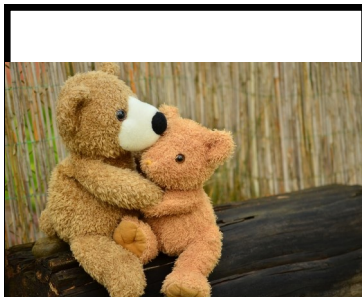
