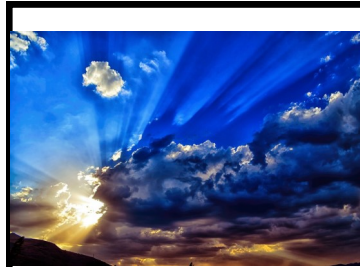
This Evening
